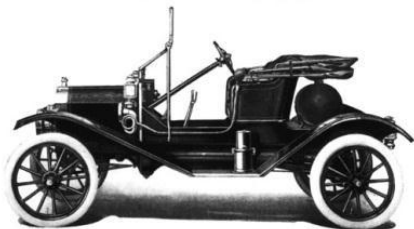

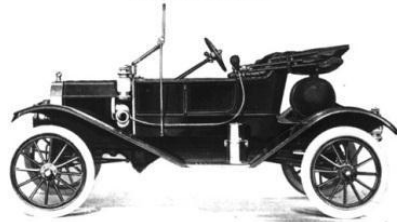


2-Passenger Open Runabout, Fully Equipped
